### ***Dear Parishioners and Friends***

We have had some very inspiring Scripture readings at the weekday Masses over the past couple of weeks, and some really gripping stories, with the prophet Elijah taking centre stage. He suffered greatly at the hands of the King, Ahab, and his wife Jezebel, and almost came to the point of wanting to give up; but he didn't! Most of the kings of Judah were not good kings. They allowed the worship of false gods to take over from true worship of the god of Abraham, Issac and Jacob. This week, though, we heard about a good king, Hezekiah, and how he managed to defeat the Assyrian king, Sennacherib. Today, Friday, however, as I write, we have learnt about the Babylonian king, Nebuchadnezzar, succeeding in attacking Jerusalem, perpetrating terrible atrocities, and deporting most of the population of Jerusalem to Babylon.

I have just been asked why we read these stories during Mass. The answer is that they tell us about our extraordinary history in faith. The whole of the Old Testament, the Hebrew Scriptures, map out how God interacts with humanity and how human beings themselves reach out to know about God. This relationship is a tempestuous one – on humanity's side. Our all-loving, patient, caring God is constantly rebuffed by the infidelity of God's people, and as we see so vividly in today's world, human selfishness and sin warp our perspectives.

We live in a world of sinfulness and selfishness and self-interest; yet God is always there – here- even in our darkest moments. We may abandon God. God never abandons us.
