Dear Parishioners and Friends

During the week Fr Joseph and I received letters from Archbishop Malcolm expressing our official appointments to St Elizabeth's parish as well as St Anne's. What is new is that our Official duties to the people of the parishes extend to a fruitful collaboration with other clergy in providing care to the local hospitals and hospices within your territory. What this means is that both of us will now be involved in the chaplaincy to Southport hospital as well as Ormskirk hospital, taking our turns on the rota for emergency calls day and night. Up till now I have always been on call at Ormskirk hospital but Southport is very much more busy than Ormskirk.

We bore this in mind when we had a meeting with St Elizabeth's parishioners on Wednesday when we met to look to the coming months and how we can best serve both parishes. I am grateful to all those who attended because we had to make some significant decisions, especially about the times of Mass at the weekend. In short, the following emerged from our discussions:

- · Given that both our parishes have been designated a Family of Parishes we have had to look to see how we can share our resources for the good of all our parishioners.
- · From Saturday 28 September there will no longer be a vigil Mass in St Elizabeth's Church. There will continue to be a vigil Mass at 5pm in St Anne's. Numbers at the St Elizabeth's Mass are very low. All the other local parishes have vigil Masses and with two priests now serving our two parishes it will be helpful for one of us to assist in other parishes when the priest there is away.
- From Sunday 29 September Mass in St Elizabeth's will be at 9am instead of at 9.30. This will make it possible for one priest to preside at Masses in both parishes when one of us is away. Sunday Mass in St Anne's will continue to be at 1030.
- At the moment we shall continue to have one weekday Mass in St Elizabeth's at 9.30am on Wednesdays.
- We shall have a joint weekly bulletin for both parishes, as was the custom a few years ago. This will enable everyone to see what is happening in both parishes.
- Each parish will have its own Parish Pastoral Council but we hope there will be a representative from each parish on both councils.
- In both parishes there will be a Harvest Festival celebration on Sunday 22 September.

Thank you all for your understanding. I am delighted that I shall be serving St Elizabeth's again and am most grateful to Archbishop Malcolm for the gift of Fr Joseph to our communities. I know that you have already taken him to your hearts and may the Lord help us all to grow in our faith and be servants of one another.
